Wolf Pack Field Trip Form

Hello Parents and Guardians,

We are taking **The Wolf Pack** out to roam! We will be taking a field trip from Wildlife Images, using our transport van. At our destination we will be hiking and engaging in outdoor activities, regardless of the weather. It is important that you send your child fully equipped for the day with the following items:

- **A big lunch and filling snacks**
- **Two large, refillable water bottles (20 oz or more each)**
- **Sturdy, closed-toed shoes**
- **A backpack to easily carry these items on our hike**
- **Sunscreen, sunglasses, a hat (prep for high heat)**
- **Swim suit and towel**
- **Dress in layers on top and we suggest wearing shorts**

Our field trip is near water and it would be fantastic to take a dip in the high heat. Our facilitators are experienced in risk assessment and will evaluate the situation prior to any water based activity; Please indicate the level of your child's swimming ability, erring on the side of caution:

_____ **Not a Swimmer** (*Does not know how to swim, not comfortable in water*)

_____ **Weak Swimmer** (*Can swim, may need assistance from flotation device, cannot tread water: doggy paddle stage*)

_____ **Good Swimmer** (*Comfortable in water, can tread water, can swim for a length of time without touching bottom*)

_____ **Strong Swimmer** (*Difficult to get OUT of the water! Very comfortable, can tread water, swim for lengths of time without touching bottom; future lifeguard, possibly part mermaid/merman*)

Is there anything else we should be aware of? (*i.e., physical conditions, heat problems, medical problems, experience in the outdoors, poison oak allergy, etc.*)
