Applicants must also be enthusiastic about working with children and have experience working with children in a professional or educational setting.

Internship Description:

Interns will have the opportunity to...

- Work outside and around animals in the park
- Learn and present ambassador animal encounters to camp kids
- Play games and host activities
- Develop educational activities and curriculum
- Participate in animal experiences such as feeding our resident animals, developing enrichment, learning about husbandry, and helping with group enclosure makeovers
- Experience weekly camp themes such as: Animal Hospital, Kritter Kitchen, Going Buggy, Shark Week and Wildlife Warriors
- Help mentor middle school junior keepers

- Adhere to COVID-19 regulations and proper disinfecting and cleaning protocols
- Help with preparation work such as copying and gathering supplies for crafts
